Funds raised through Hearts & Wine support Harvest Against Hunger's work for those in need in our community. We provide millions of pounds of produce annually to families and individuals using Washington food banks. During this pandemic, we have moved rapidly to provide what food banks told us they most needed: face masks for employees and volunteers, refurbished laptops for food bank records and communication, increased capacity for refrigeration, and more. HAH collects and distributes produce and other vital items to more than 400 food banks and meal programs statewide by working with our food bank partners. Additionally, we feed Washington's hungry through our Harvest VISTA program that places AmeriCorps VISTA volunteers at food banks for 3 years, as well as VISTA Associates each summer to help during the growing and harvest times. Through our AmeriCorps program, we help hunger-relief programs become self-reliant in securing local, fresh donations of fruits and vegetables for their clients while simultaneously reducing food waste.
